ABSTRACT

The research examines the influence of spatial policy implementation on green natural space utilization effectiveness of urban area in Cimahi Municipality. Observations indicate there is still a problem in the green natural space utilization of urban area that has not been effective. This problem, caused by factors of spatial policy implementation undertaken by the relevant agencies have not been effective.

Problem questions in this study were: 1) What is the spatial policy implementation affects on green natural space utilization effectiveness of urban area in Cimahi Municipality; 2) How much the influence of spatial policy implementation on green natural space utilization effectiveness of urban area in Cimahi Municipality.

The research design using the method of explanatory survey with quantitative approach. Techniques of data analysis using Structural Equation Models (SEM). Techniques of data collection is done through literature study and field study by distributing questionnaires, observation, and interviews with relevant agencies and some society residents of Cimahi Municipality.

The results of the research showed that the spatial policy implementation significantly influence to the green natural space utilization effectiveness of urban area in Cimahi Municipality. Dimensions of The interorganizational communication and enforcement activities, have the highest impact, the economic, social and political conditions, and the dimensions of the policy resources have a high impact, while the characteristics of the implementing agencies, the policy resources, and the disposition of implementors have the low influence.

Conclusion the study did not produce a new concept, but it only reinforces the theory of policy implementation from Van Horn and Van Meter. Reinforcement theory based on research results, is: "The influence of spatial policy implementation on effectiveness of the use of more powerful RTHKP determined by the dimensions of The interorganizational communication and enforcement activities, the economic, social, and political conditions, and the policy resources, compared with the characteristics of the implementing agencies, the dimensions of standard and objectives policy, as well as the disposition of implementors".
