

## **ABSTRAK**

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mendeskripsikan dan menganalisis pelaksanaan komitmen pemerintah Indonesia dalam mencapai MDG's pertama yakni penanggulangan kemiskinan dan kelaparan. Jika dilihat dari perspektif keamanan manusia, terutama keamanan ekonomi dan keamanan pangan bagaimana negara ini melindungi masyarakat dari ancaman kemiskinan dan kelaparan.

Penelitian ini menggunakan metode kualitatif studi kasus. Pengumpulan data dilakukan melalui dokumentasi dan wawancara kepada informan representatif dari pemerintah yaitu Utusan Khusus Presiden RI untuk MDG's, Sekretariat MDG's Nasional, Deputy Director of Economic Development and Environmental Affairs Kementerian Luar Negeri RI; dan informan dari Lembaga yaitu Koordinator Divisi Advokasi dan Jaringan LSM Sajogyo Institute; Peneliti tentang perburuhan dan pangan LSM Akatiga.

Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa berbagai upaya dan program pemerintah Indonesia untuk menanggulangi kemiskinan dan kelaparan dalam rangka MDG's, pada satu sisi berkontribusi memberikan keamanan secara ekonomi dan pangan bagi masyarakat yang terkena manfaatnya, tetapi pada sisi yang lain pelaksanaan di lapangan terlihat selalu ada kesenjangan dan permasalahan. Hal itu ditambah dengan berbagai tantangan yang membuat upaya pemerintah belum sepenuhnya kondusif bagi keamanan manusia, yaitu kebebasan dan kesejahteraan masyarakat.

## **ABSTRACT**

*This research is intended to describe and analyze the implementation of Indonesian government's commitment in achieving the MDG's goal one which is eradicating extreme poverty and hunger. Viewed from the perspective of human security, mainly from economic and food security, how the government protects its people from threats of poverty and hunger.*

*The method used in this research is qualitative method, case study. Data collection is based on documentation and interviews with informants from government representatives which are the Special envoy of the Indonesian president for MDG's, Deputy Director of Economic Development and Environmental Affairs in Foreign Ministry RI, National MDG'S Secretariat; and informants from NGO's which are the Division Advocacy and Networking Coordinator from Sajogyo Institute, and the researcher on labor and food from Akatiga.*

*The research results show that the Indonesian government various means and programs to eradicate poverty and hunger in the framework of MDG's contribute to provide economic and food security for people who get the benefits and already reached by these programs, but in the other side their implementation still has a disparity and raise many issues in the fields. Added to that different other challenges make the efforts of the government not fully conducive to provide human security, otherwise the freedom and well-being of people.*
