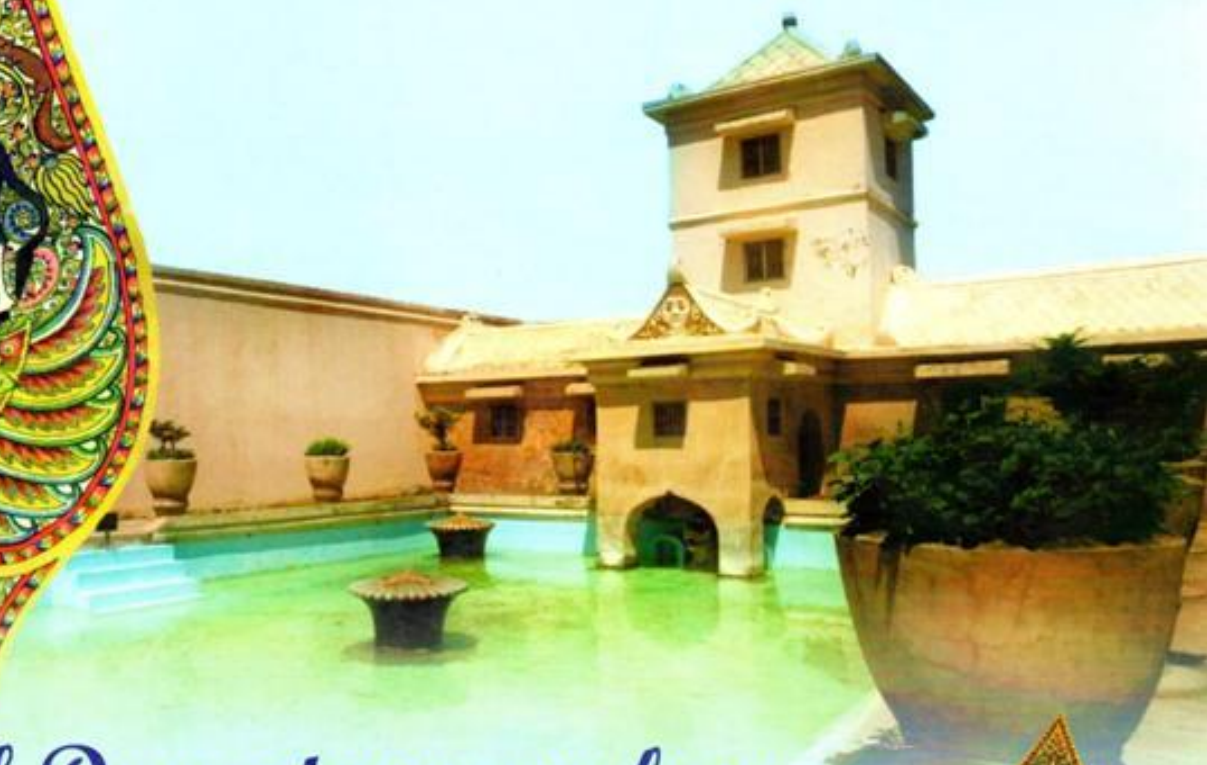

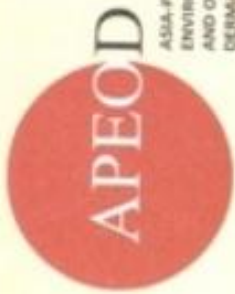

ULCERATED INFANTILE HEMANGIOMA TREATED WITH ORAL PROPRANOLOL, NECROTOMY, AND MODERN WOUND DRESSINGS

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Background. Infantile hemangioma (IH) is the most common benign vascular tumor of childhood with ulceration as the most frequent complication. Oral propranolol has been reported to be effective to treat ulcerated IH and decrease pain. Modern wound dressing can accelerate the healing of ulcers.

Case. A 3-month-old girl was consulted to Dermatovenereology Outpatient Clinic of Dr. Hasan Sadikin General Hospital with rubbery, non-compressible, dark red tumor on the inner left arm extending to the left palm sized 18x15x0.5 cm. The patient was diagnosed as segmental infantile hemangioma and initially treated with oral prednisone. On day 27th of follow-up, ulcers appeared on the tumor surface and secondarily infected. Therefore, the oral corticosteroid was replaced with oral propranolol 2mg/kgBW/day, then was increased to 2,5 mg/kgBW/day. The ulcers were also treated with necrotomy and application of modern dressing (antimicrobial, foam, and hydrogel). After 15 weeks of propranolol treatment the tumor became smaller and thinner with 15x13x0,2 cm in size, and ulcers were completely healed leaving scar formation. No side effect of propranolol was noted.

Discussion. Aberrant angiogenesis is the main etiology of IH, therefore propranolol can be used in the treatment of IH because of its vasoconstriction, angiogenesis inhibition, and apoptosis induction effects. Modern wound dressing create moist environment that increase reepithelialization and stimulate collagen synthesis. For complicated hemangioma such as ulceration and infection, like in this case, comprehensive management is needed, including systemic therapy (propranolol and antibiotic), necrotomy, and modern wound dressing.

CHILDHOOD BULLOUS PEMPHIGOID TREATED WITH CORTICOSTEROID SPARING-THERAPY WITH AZATHIOPRINE IN AN 18-YEAR-OLD GIRL: A CASE REPORT

Background. Bullous Pemphigoid (BP) is rarely found in childhood. It is established based on BP diagnostic criteria with patient's age up to 18 years old. Combination therapy (steroid sparing-therapy) can be used to minimize steroid side effect. Azathioprine was chosen because of its rapid action, therefore complete remission can be obtained quickly.

Case. An 18-year-old girl was admitted to Dermatovenereology Department, Dr. Hasan Sadikin Hospital Bandung, with chief complaints of blisters and itchy erythematous macules distributed widely on almost her entire body, except the scalp, lower legs, and feet. History taking, physical examination, routine laboratory analysis, histopathology examination, and direct immunofluorescence were done to conclude the diagnosis.

Discussion. The lesions were erythematous macules, plaques, and tense blisters that initially occurred on both arms, then spread to almost her entire body. On observation, the blisters tended to spread on the oral mucous membrane. Histopathological examination revealed subepidermal vesicobullous reaction with minimal erythrocyte, lymphocyte, and eosinophil. Direct immunofluorescence revealed immunoglobulin G deposit at the dermoepidermal junction. The patient was given intravenous dexamethasone, which then replaced with methylprednisolone equals to 0 mg/kgBW/day prednisone when she was discharged from the hospital. Sparing-therapy given on day 13th was 50 mg azathioprine, twice daily, orally. Improvement was seen at the 10th days of sparing-therapy administration.
